Dear Applicant:

This scholarship honoring Emeritus Professor Thanasis Maskaleris founding director of Modern Greek Studies at San Francisco State University (1981-1996), provides financial support to continuing undergraduate or graduate students interested in Modem Greek Studies.

The goal of the Scholarship Committee is to annually establish the number and amount of the scholarship awards tor that year consistent with its financial resources. The scholarship(s) will be awarded for one year and will expire at the end of that year. Winners are eligible to apply for another award during the following application period.

This year there will be awarded two one-year scholarships, each of \$1200, or one \$2400 scholarship.

Awards are based on academic achievement, leadership, service, and financial need.

To qualify for a Thanasis Maskaleris Scholarship you must:

- 1. Be enrolled in 12 units (undergraduates), or 6 or more units (graduates) in study leading to a degree at San Francisco State University.
- 2. Be currently enrolled in a Modern Greek Studies or Modern Greek Studies related course and have taken at least one Modem Greek Studies course the previous year and maintain a 3.0 average in those classes and in your overall GPA.
- 3. Be already receiving financial aid at San Francisco State University or provide evidence of financial need by providing a statement of need.
- 4. Be willing upon receiving an award, to write a letter to acknowledge receipt of the award. Within six months after receipt of the award to write a letter to describe how the scholarship was applied and what your accomplishments have been since receipt of the award.

Scholarship award funds are sent to the recipients after the Chairperson of the Scholarship Committee has received proof of college registration or certified enrollment and a class schedule.

The recipient of a scholarship shall forfeit the award if she/he fails to attend San Francisco State University or she/he fails to pursue pertinent study abroad within six months of being notified of the award.

2016-2017 APPLICATION

The application packet must consist of:

- 1. The scholarship application with financial information forms attached, as appropriate.
- 2. The latest available official transcripts from all post secondary institutions including San Francisco State University.
- 3. An official copy of your current class schedule and proof of enrollment/registration.
- 4. A typed or legibly written statement of not more than 500 words describing how this award will further your long term goals and how Modern Greek Studies will contribute to your future goals and personal development.
- 5. Two letters of recommendation, one from a Modern Greek Studies faculty member, and one from another member of the San Francisco State University faculty. The recommendation forms are attached, and may be duplicated.

Failure to include any of the aforementioned documents will result in disqualification.

The deadline for submitting your completed application packet for the 2016-2017 school year is September 30, 2016. The packet must be postmarked on or before September 30, 2016.
